Friendly Reminder

It is very important that children complete their reading challenge every day. In Year 4 the children are responsible for signing their reading record. We recommend 10-15 minutes of reading each night.

Homework is handed out every Thursday and is due back in the following Tuesday. Homework is then marked ready for Thursday. It is important that the children are completing their homework, it revises what they should already know in maths and English and builds on their skills and confidence in these subject areas. Along with homework, we send home weekly spellings. These do not need to be brought back into school. Keep practising as often as possible and remember to go back over old lists to check that children are still remembering the spelling rules. Thank you
