Times Tables!

In Year 4 it is very important that children know all of their times tables and are able to confidently answer any times table questions given to them.

In the summer term, children will be taking part in a times table test. During this test, children answer 25 random times table questions using a laptop. The children will only have six seconds to answer each question. This is why it so important for the children to be confident in their times table knowledge. We will be practising all of the times tables up to 12 x 12 in school each day.
