

Prime Area of Learning

Personal, Social and Emotional

- The children will be encouraged to talk about the things they are able to do
- The children will be confident to speak to others about own needs, wants, interests and opinions
- Behavioural expectations will be continually reinforced.
- The children will be encouraged to resolve conflicts by finding a compromise.

Prime Area of Learning

Physical Development

- The children will continue to practise the kinetic letter families
- The children will be encouraged to travel with confidence and skill around, under and through balancing and climbing equipment
- The children show understanding of the need for safety when tackling new challenges and consider and manage some risks.

Prime Area of Learning

Communication and Language

- The children will listen to stories—predicting outcomes and responding to them with relevant comments, questions or actions.
- The children will follow instructions involving several ideas or actions
- The children will be encouraged to use talk to organise, sequence and clarify their thinking ideas, feelings and events

Specific Area of Learning

Mathematics

- Recognise numerals 1 to 10
- Count out up to 10 objects from a larger group
- Children select the correct numeral to represent 1 to 10 objects
- Children count an irregular arrangement of up to 10 objects.
- Order 2 or 3 items by length or height
- Orders two items by weight or capacity

Specific Area of Learning

Understanding the World

- The children will be exploring different occupations and ways of life
- The children will talk about past events in their own life
- We will be celebrating the Chinese New Year and learning about different beliefs, attitudes, customs and traditions.
- The children will record their observations using technology.

Specific Area of Learning

Literacy-Reading and Writing

- Tales Toolkit will be introduced— creating our own stories
- Books by the author Tony Mitton will form the basis of our story sessions
- Relevant books about real life heroes will be incorporated throughout the environment
- Phonics will be taught and practised daily. "Letters and Sounds" is the phonic programme used. We will begin blending letters for reading and segmenting letters for spelling as well as building up a sight vocabulary
- Emergent writing will be encouraged across all areas of learning
- Sentence writing will be modelled and taught daily and the children will be writing Pop and Pip sentences.

Specific Area of Learning

Expressive Arts and Design

- The children will be encouraged to use available resources to create props to support role play
- The children will be encouraged to perform "The squeaky door"
- The children will be encouraged to make music and dance
- The children will create different textures and combine different media to create new effects.
