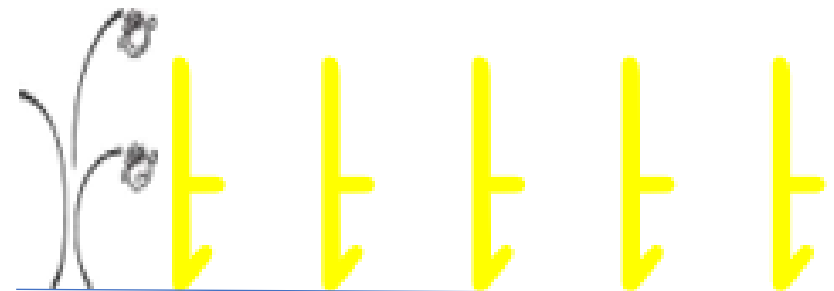
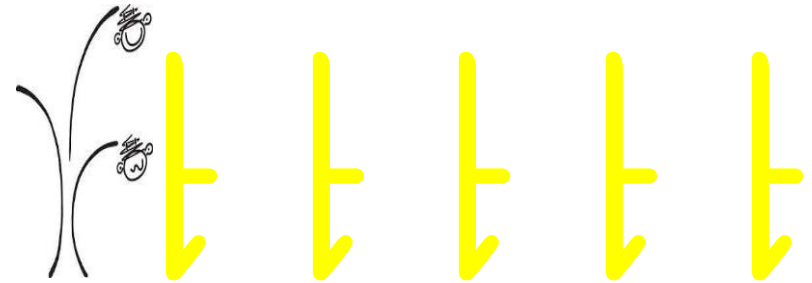


It is part of the Window Cleaner family when we write it we can say...

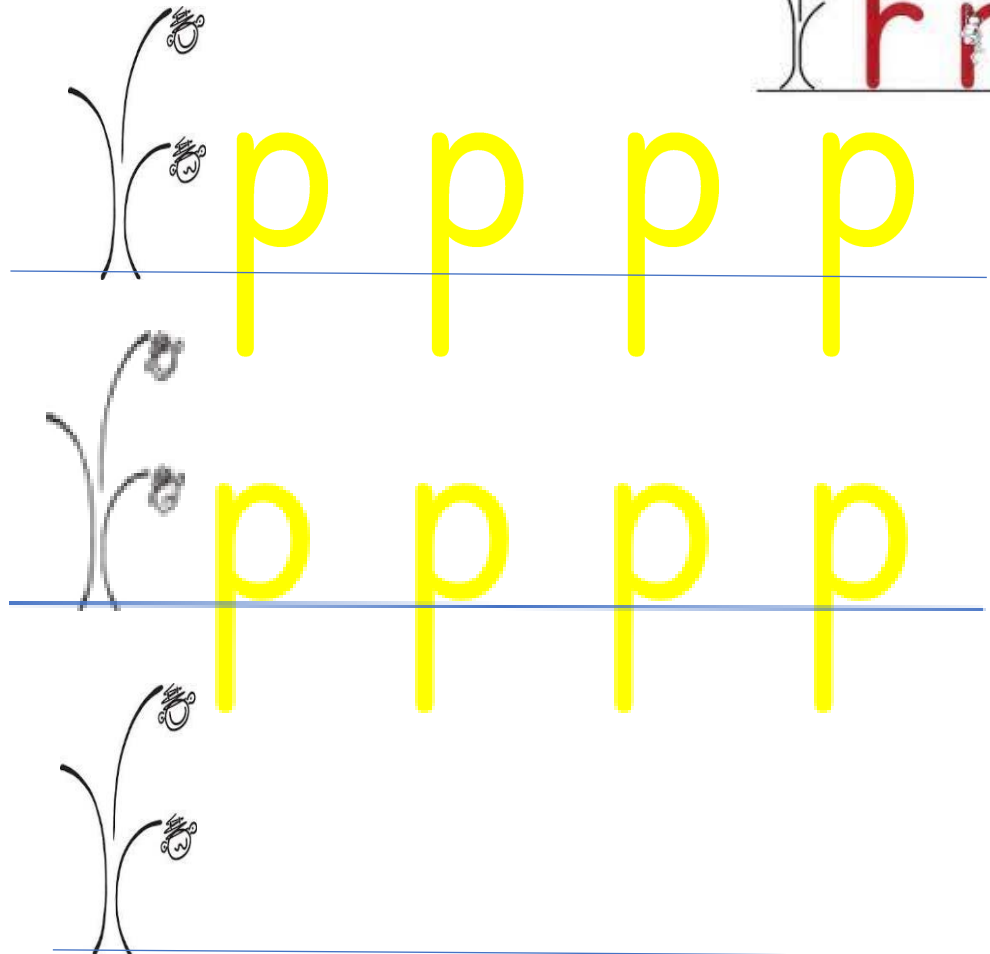
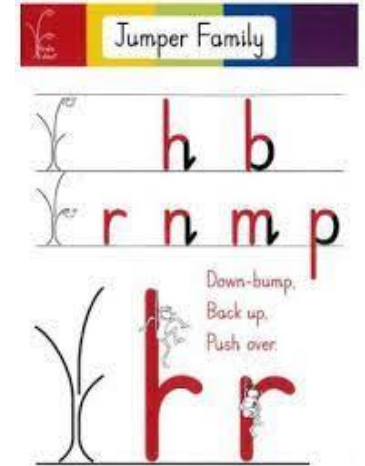
