## Communication and Language





We will watch some Topsy and Tim stories and Dr Ranj both can be watched on BBC iplayer.


Numbers and counting-pairing the socks and shoes into two's, How many pairs do we have? Which shoes are yours?


We will be pouring quantities of medicines and counting out buttons for tablets to make the babies/ animals better.






