Spelling and Reading



We have spelling lessons each Tuesday and Thursday. Children will be given new spellings each week to be practised at home.

We love to read in Shakespeare! This year we will continue to use Reading Vipers to help us with our guided reading. These can be used at home when reading too. In our guided reading lessons this term we will be focusing on the vocabulary, infer and retrieve vipers.







Writing



We will link our history work to our English writing this term. We will write a non-chronological report on the day of the dead celebrations in Mexico. Furthermore, we will be writing a persuasive letter encouraging people to visit Mexico.

Maths



In maths this term we will build on our knowledge of numbers up to 10 million, as well as the four operations: addition and subtraction, multiplication and division.

Science



Our science topic is 'Light up your world'. In this topic students will learn to:

- · recognise that light appears to travel in straight lines
- use the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain that objects are seen because they give out or reflect light into the eye
- explain that we see things because light travels from light sources to our eyes or from light sources to objects and then to our eyes
- use the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain why shadows have the same shape as the objects that cast them.

Computing

In computing our learners will develop their understanding of how digital images can be changed and edited, and how they can then be resaved and reused. They will consider the impact that editing images can have and evaluate the effectiveness of their choices.

Geography/History

Children will learn about the remarkable achievements of the ancient Maya. Through these activities pupils will learn about the Maya perspective of time, the calendar system, writing, maths and the environment.

MFL

During this half term the children will revisit personal information question and answers and extended feelings. They will recall how to give opinions of school subjects including reasons and recall numbers to 60. Children will be introduced to the 'o'clock' structure in French, and key daily routine phrases in order to be able to write a sequence of daily routine phrases and ask and answer questions about daily routine.
