Mr Redhead and Mrs Tansey hope you have had a wonderful Christmas break and are ready for the term ahead. We have lots of exciting topics to study this term.



Spelling and Reading

We have spelling lessons each Wednesday and Friday. Children will be given new spellings each week to be practised at home using EdShed – http://play.edshed.com Your child has their own password.

The adults in our class love to read, we hope you do too. This year we will continue to use Reading Vipers to help us with our guided reading. These can be used at home when reading too. In our guided reading lessons this term we will be focusing on the vocabulary, infer and retrieve vipers.









Writing We will link our Geography theme Life in the Oceans to our English writing. This half term we are learning how to write non-chronological reports and recounts. We are planning a school trip to the Sea Life Centre in Birmingham and will be base some of writing on the trip.

Maths



We would like to invite all parents to join their child in Year 4 on Monday 16th January for a maths workshop. More details will follow shortly.

In maths this term we will look at and formal written methods for multiplication, and division. We will then be learning about perimeter and length before beginning a unit on fractions.



Science

Our science topic is 'Our changing world'. In this topic we will look at how we can classify different species of trees and plants. Later we will learn about habitats and groups of animals who live in them.



Computing

In computing we will be learning about animation. Who to animate obkjects, people and also use stop motion animation techniques too.

Geography & School Trip

In Geography this half term is theme Life in the Oceans. We be learning lots about the biomes and climate zones across the World. We will be visiting the Sea Life Centre in Birmingham on 18 January and will be seeing first hand the diverse range of life which habits the various aquatic biomes. We will also look at the impact humans have on these biomes, including the global issues surrounding single use plastics and how plastic impacts of aquatic life.



MFL

In French we will be looking at school and subjects. We will learn to speak as well as write sentences about this in French.

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Music

In music each week we listen and appraise a range of different music genres. This half term we be exploring the music from Abba and learning how to sing and play Mama Mia on the glockenspiels.

PE

Tuesday – Indoor PE (Outdoor as weather permits)

Thursday – Swimming lessons. Your child needs to be in school earlier than usual. We will be ready to leave at 8:35am to walk to the swimming pool. If your child is not ready to leave at 8:35 they will remain in school.

On PE days please wear tracksuit bottoms or shorts and an academy PE. Don't forget to wear trainers.



Homework

Each week your child should complete the 3 following activities:



4-5 x Home reading sessions with an adult – Quick note recorded in diary. A mixture of Big Cat online e-books and the read book we change each week.



30 minutes -TT Rockstars multiplication practice.



Ed Shed Spelling practice - Minimum 2-3 sessions each week. We have our weekly spelling check each Friday
