IMPORTANT: Nut allergies

I am writing again to ask for your support.

As you know from Mrs Albert's letter last week, we have a number of children in school with **severe nut allergies**. **Should any of these children come into contact with nuts, it may be necessary for the staff to administer an EpiPen and call an ambulance.**

Obviously, this is a very serious and potentially **life-threatening** matter for the children concerned. I ask you again to **not send your child to school with a packed lunch that contains peanut butter, chocolate hazelnut spread, raw nuts of any kind or any other item that may contain nuts.**

I fully appreciate that your child(ren) may have their favourite 'spreads' or chocolate filled items but I'm sure you will agree that **the life of a child must be our priority.**

We will continue to monitor lunchboxes this week and will contact you if we feel it necessary.
