Welcome

Welcome back to term 2! We hope you have had a lovely half term break. This term we will be very busy in class with our new learning and have a fabulous trip to Flag Fenn to look forward to.

Spelling and Reading

This year we will have our test spelling on a Friday and new spellings will be sent home on a Friday. In reading we are continuing to work on our inference and explanation skills as well as retrieval. We will be focussing on backing up the points we are making using evidence from the text.



Writing

In English this term we will be writing using our class text from last half term, Peter Pan, to describe the characters and a setting description.

We will also be using our knowledge gained in our science lessons last half term to write a text discussing “What have we learned about the ancient Egyptians from what they left behind?”



Maths

In Maths, we will continue to work on our addition and subtraction skills, looking at estimation and Focusing on adding 3 digit numbers by 2 digit numbers. After this we will then move on to Multiplication and division.



Science

Our science topic this term is Cycles in Nature, We will look The Four Seasons, Seasonal Cycles in Plants, Life Cycle of a Plant, Animal Migration and the Life Cycle of a Frog



Computing

There are no planned computing lessons for this term.



Art & Design/Design & Technology

In art we will be studying lines in art. We will study at how artists can vary the weight of their line and then look at Hokusai and one of his famous pieces of art called “The Great Wave” they will finish the unit by make polytile printing blocks.



In DT we will be making a key ring/festive decoration for use by a member of your family at home or a friend.

Geography/History

Our history topic this term is “Ancient Egypt”. We will be learning about where Egypt and the River Nile is, Life in Ancient Egypt, Religion and the Afterlife, Tutankhamen, Howard Carter and Hieroglyphics

Our Geography topic this term is Settlements. We will be focusing on understanding what a settlement is, types of Settlements, Urban, Rural and Suburban areas, Population Density and What do settlements need?



Music

In music we will be looking at introducing your child to learn about the language of music through playing the glockenspiel.
