Spelling and Reading

We have spelling lessons each Wednesday and Friday. Children will be given new spellings each week to be practised at home using EdShed – http://play.edshed.com Your child has their own password.

The adults in our class love to read, we hope you do too. This year we will continue to use Reading Vipers to help us with our guided reading. These can be used at home when reading too. In our guided reading lessons this term we will be focusing on the vocabulary, infer and retrieve vipers.







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Writing

This half term the children are learning how to write an explanation text as well developing their knowledge of using verbs and conjunctions.



Maths

In maths this term the children will continue to their development of adding and subtraction to 10000. Children will be using mental and formal written methods of the four operations: addition and subtraction, multiplication, and division



Our science topic is 'classification of plants and animals' In this topic the children will study the key groups of carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.



Computing

In computing we will be learning to use technology to experiment and compose a piece of music. In addition the children will learning about the benefits of using technology, how to reduce risks to themselves when online and what is appropriate when using, referring and presenting the work of other, including plagiarism.



Geography & History

In Geography this half term our theme is 'Mediterranean Europe'. We be expanding existing knowledge of Europe and use of maps. In History will continue learning about the Anglo-Saxons & Vikings and their impact on the UK.



MFL

In French we will be looking at school and subjects. We will learn to speak as well as write sentences about this in French. We will learn the days of the week and months of year.



Music

In music Children will continue learning the Ukulele each week.



PE Tuesday & Thursday — Outdoor (as weather permits) On PE days please wear tracksuit bottoms or shorts and an academy PE. Remember to wear trainers.

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Homework

Each week your child should complete the 3 following activities:



4-5 x Home reading sessions with an adult – Quick note recorded in diary. A mixture of Big Cat online e-books and the read book we change each week.

Ed Shed Spelling practice - Minimum 2-3 sessions each week. We have our weekly spelling check each Friday
