KS2 SATs 2024

Here are the dates for when the National KS2 SATs and assessments will take place in May/June 2024.

Monday 13th May – English grammar, punctuation, and spelling papers

Tuesday 14th May – English reading paper Wednesday 15th May – Math's papers 1 & 2 Thursday 16 May – Math's paper 3 – end of tests

Phonics Screening Check for Year 1 children

Year 1 children will complete their phonics screening check in the week beginning Monday 10th June 2024.

Phonics Screening Check for Year 2 children

The children who did not pass their phonics screening check within the 1- week period at the end of Year 1 will complete it in the week beginning Monday 10th June 2024.

Multiplication check for Year 4 children

Year 4 children will complete the multiplication check within the 2-week periods starting Monday 3rd June 2024.
