

# Year 4 Newsletter – Autumn 1

Welcome to year 4! We are sending out our Autumn term 1 newsletter early during our transition day so you have information about your child's new class ahead of the summer break. ## Welcome

Welcome to Year 4! I hope your children had a restful summer holiday and are excited to return. Mrs Eden and I are thrilled to be working with your children and look forward to encouraging them to be the best version of themselves. We have high expectations for the children this year and will motivate them to achieve their best.

I have put together some information that I thought would be useful for you to enable you to support your child's education this term.

## Spelling and Reading

This year we will have our test spelling on a Thursday and new spellings will be sent home on the same day. In reading we be focusing on fluency and reading for meaning.



Our class texts this term will be The Firework-Maker's Daughter- Phillip Pullman and Rumaysa – a Fairy Tale

## Writing

We will be writing a fiction piece based on the short film Dream Giver. We will also be writing a non chronological report on about the “Rock Cycle” as well as an essay based on our geography topic. We will be describing how Corby has changed over time.



## Maths

In maths we will start the year looking at place value: reading and writing numbers to 10000, comparing and ordering numbers

We will then move on to the four operations: addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

We will work on adding and subtracting, 10's & 100's and 1000s adding and subtracting two 4 digit numbers.



## Science

Our science topic this term is “The Human Body”. We will be learning about how cells are the building blocks of the human body and we need nutrition to keep our bodies working as they should, the teeth and senses, digestion and the process of digestion and vitamins and minerals and understanding a healthy diet.



## Computing

In computing we will be about networks.



## Art & Design/Design & Technology

In art we will be studying “light” in art. We will look at drawing dark and light, painting dark and light, we will be painting a still life with acrylic using ground and underpainting as techniques and then using tints and shade to show form. This will help children understand how artists use and show light in different ways.



In Design Technology we will be looking at different sewing techniques and designing then making cushions.

## Geography/History

Our history topic this term is “Ancient Greece”. We will be learning about all the city states in Ancient Greece, understanding Athens and the importance of democracy, Sparta and their thirst for War, The Persian Wars, Alexander the Great and Greek Philosophy. (This is a 12-week unit and will continue into next half term)



Our Geography topic this term is ‘Spatial Sense’. We will be focusing on recognising geographical tools on a globe, looking at scale for distance, recapping grid references, recognise key features of Corby and understand how Corby has changed over time.

## Music

In music this term the children will be listening to different work songs – sea shanties and bhangra songs (from Punjab, India). The children will then create a work song using percussion instruments to keep a steady beat.



## PE

PE days are Wednesday and Thursday so please remember to send your child to school dressed in PE kit on those days. Both lessons will be outdoors.

Children may stay in PE kit all day. Long hair to be tied up and **no jewellery please**. Thank you.

## Reminders


As a reminder, our school uniform for key stage 2 is a white shirt with a purple cardigan/ jumper with black trousers/skirt and black shoes.
