Welcome

Welcome back to term 2. We're eagerly anticipating all the exciting learning opportunities that await us in the coming months over this very busy term.

This newsletter details information about the second term's curriculum and what your child will be studying in the second term of Year 4. It will also give you key dates for term 2 at the bottom of the newsletter.

Spelling and Reading

This year we will have our test spelling on a Thursday and new spellings will be sent home on the same day. In reading we be focusing on fluency and retrieving information from the text.



Our class texts this term will be Leo and the Gorgon's Curse and Who Let the Gods Out.

Writing

We will be writing a fiction piece based on our reading last term "The Firework Maker's Daughter". We will also be writing a non fiction piece comparing Athens and Sparta. We will finally be writing an essay based on our History topic "How did the Ancient Greeks change the world?"



Maths

We will work on addition and subtraction, multiplication and division as well as interpreting data. **PLEASE ENCOURAGE YOUR CHILD TO GO ONTO TT ROCKSTARS REGULARLY TO PRACTISE THEIR TIMES TABLES.**



Science

Our science topic this term is "Classification of Plants and Animals." We will be learning about the different classes of vertebrates and invertebrates and also the classification of plants.



Computing

In computing we will be learning how to create media, more specifically an audio production.



Art & Design

In art we will be studying "space" in art. We will look at an introduction to space and dimensions, We will explore space in painting: foreground, middle ground and background – identifying and creating foreground, middle ground and background and then finally using colour and detail to show depth.



Geography/History

Our history topic this term is "Ancient Greece". We will be learning about Greek gods, mythology, Arts and architecture, the Ancient Olympic Games and the lasting legacy of Ancient Greece (This will conclude the 12 week unit.



Our Geography topic this term is 'Mediterranean Europe.' We will look at key places in Europe, the climate of Mediterranean Europe, food, farming, landscape and settlements.

Music

This term we will be studying Take the A Train and swing music. The children will be improvising and composing this style of music.



PE

PE days are **WEDNESDAY AND THURSDAY** so please remember to send your child to school dressed in PE kit on those days.

Children may stay in PE kit all day. Long hair to be tied up and **no jewellery please**. Thank you.
