Multi Sports and Creative Activities Course

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Join us this **February Half Term** on our refreshed **Multi Sports and Creative Activities Course for 2026**.

On our course, children between the ages of 5 and 16 engage in age specific activities, ranging from our Multi Sports offer with a focus on sports activities such as; 5-aside Football, Kwik Cricket, Bench Ball, Hockey to name a few, through to our Creative offer, encompassing activities such as; Clay Modelling, Crafting, STEM Engineering Challenges, Theatre School and much more.

Alongside our activities, we run our **#BeAChampion** initiative which is wholly focused on celebrating children's efforts and attitude whilst they are with us. Our ethos is simple, **Be You – Be Kind – Be Great!** We want all children that attend our courses to have fun in a safe environment, express themselves fully and create positive relationships that increase their confidence and resilience both individually and in others. Children are awarded **#BeAChampion** cards in line with our three core content areas that are **#BeHealthy**, **#BeActive** and **#BeCreative**.

Who can apply?

Our courses are open to all school aged children from Reception to Year 11. We offer paid places, (including sibling discounts and reduced rates for children on roll at our Partner Schools) and funded places. Students may be eligible for a funded place via the Holiday, Activities and Food programme if they are in receipt of benefits related Free School Meals.

What is the Holiday Activities and Food programme (HAF)

The Holiday Activities and Food programme (HAF) is a government funded programme that provides free holiday clubs for Reception to Year 11 students in receipt of benefits-related free school meals across the Easter, Summer and Christmas holidays – latterly extending this to February HT.

A healthy meal and drinks will be provided each day, as a part of the offer. If any additional items are required, you will be informed of this prior to booking. However, we would request children to have the appropriate clothing and footwear.
